Some Questions are more appropriate for all contractors, while some are geared more toward a general contractor or specialized subcontractor. The following list of questions is intended as a guide. Whether you need to manage the project from long distance, hiring a general contractor or hiring all subcontractors; make sure to tailor your questions for your specific project circumstances.

- How many years have you been in business
- How many years of experience do you have in in this industry?
- Do you have pictures you can provide of similar work?
- Do you have references we can call?
- Do you usually request a deposit?
 - o If Yes, how much?
- Do you regularly take or are you capable of taking pictures of your work, in progress?
- How many trades does your company normally sub-contract out?
- Do you use project schedules to help manage your projects?
- How large is your work crew?
- How many of your crew are permanent employees?
- What is your current workload?
- How quickly can you return the bid to us?
- With your current workload, when would you be able to start our project if you are selected?
